Assign positions as a crew. For each of the following scenarios discuss the ruling, who makes the ruling, and what information you need or should communicate to others in your crew.

- 1. 1st & 10 @ B-25. Under 1:00 remaining in the 4th quarter. Team A trails by 3 points and has 1 timeout remaining. The QB rolls toward the H/S sideline. He throws an incomplete forward pass. His entire body was more than a yard over the LOS when he threw the ball.
- 2. 2nd & 7 @ A-43. Under 2:00 remaining in the half and Team A is out of timeouts in a hurry-up situation. The running back runs along the L/F sideline and is tackled inbounds, but very close to the sideline, at the B-49. Communication on clock status?
- 3. 4th & 2 @ B-20. Running back #A36 runs off the right tackle, on the H/S side of the field. At the B-21, a defender behind him punches the ball out of his hands. It rolls all the way into the back corner of the end zone. It is recovered by #A88 in front of the S before it rolls over the end line.
- 4. 1st & goal @ B-5. The pass is tipped by #B90 and intercepted at the B-2 by #B55. His momentum takes him into the end zone, fumbles in the end zone and back into the field of play. #B95 rushes to the ball, picks it up at the B-3. His momentum takes him into the end zone and he falls to the ground there.
- 5. A 2nd & 5 @ A-30. #A89 is lined up as a tight end, 2 yards outside of the tackle #A66 on the H/S side of the formation. In the backfield, #A5 lined up stationary immediately behind #A89 with none of his body inside the frame of #A66. When the ball is snapped, he remains in the backfield and runs to the L/F side of the formation. The QB fakes a handoff to #A5 and rolls behind him to throw a pass downfield. #A5 blocks low and outside of the 10-2 area prior to the QB leaving the low blocking zone. The pass is incomplete.

- 6. Team A lines up for an obvious onside kick. Six officials in the box. The kicker drives the ball directly into the ground and it pops up high in the air to the L/F sideline. Receiver #B90 gives a valid fair catch signal, but the ball is out of his reach. It goes over his head and bounces out of bounds at the B-45. He blocks a Team player before it goes out of bounds.
- 7. Try from the B-3. The kick is partially blocked and caught in the air by #B44 with his feet on the goal line near the numbers of the H/S side. Simultaneous to the catch, #B88 blocks low in the same area of #B44, who returns it all the way down the field into Team A's end zone.
- 8. 3rd & 10 @ A-20. Team A leads by 3 points late in the 4th quarter, and Team B has no timeouts. Running back #A36 runs up the middle and is immediately stopped at the LOS for no gain. While players are getting up, TE #A89 decides to slap a Team B player in the head. The referee throws his flag, stopping the game clock at 0:38.
