# TARGETING FOULS DISQUALIFICATION OVERTURNED

## PENALTY FOR (9-1-3) and (9-1-4)

- Automatic Disqualification—Reviewed by IR
- If IR Overturns The DQ AND There Is No Other Personal Foul, The 15-Yard Penalty Is Erased.
- If The Action Includes Another Personal Foul, The 15-yard Penalty For That Foul Is Enforced By Rule.



# TARGETING FOULS

## DISQUALIFICATION OVERTURNED

### EXAMPLE—PASSING PLAY

- B88 Takes Two Steps, Launches And Forcibly Hits The QB In The Head/Neck Area
- Referee Rules Roughing The Passer With Targeting (9-1-4). B88 Disqualified

### IF Instant Replay Overturns The DQ

- 15-yard Penalty For RFP Is Enforced
- B88 Returns To The Game

# TARGETING FOULS

## DISQUALIFICATION OVERTURNED

### EXAMPLE—DEFENSELESS RECEIVER

- Safety B44 Launches And Targets Pass Receiver At Head/Neck Area
- Back Judge Rules Targeting (9-1-4). B44 Disqualified

### IF Instant Replay Overturns The DQ

- 15-yard Penalty Is NOT Enforced
- B44 Returns To The Game



# TARGETING FOULS

## DISQUALIFICATION OVERTURNED

### EXAMPLE—KICK-CATCH INTERFERENCE

- Gunner A33 Forcibly Drives The Crown Of The Helmet Into The Punt Receiver Just As The Kick Arrives
- Back Judge Rules KCI With Targeting (9-1-3). A33 Disqualified

### IF Instant Replay Overturns The DQ

- 15-yard Penalty For KCI Is Enforced
- A33 Returns To The Game
