- 7 Chapters

  - Western New England (Eastern New York, Western Ma)
  - Western Pennsylvania
- Provide officials for schools from Maine to Virginia

# Western New England Chapter

- 4 Geographic areas
  - Albany
  - Berkshire
  - Mid-Hudson Valley
  - Springfield
- Executive Board
  - President
  - 1st Vice-President
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-President
  - Secretary-Treasurer
  - Directors (2)
- Committees
  - For example: Interpretation, Clinic, Screening, etc.
- If you have questions, start with fellow officials or directors or secretary.

### Who we really work for?

- Supervisors of Officials
  - AFOA (Bill Ward)
    - The schools in WNE Chapter area are:
      - Amherst, Castleton, Hamilton, HVCC, Middlebury, Norwich,
        Springfield, Western New England, Westfield State, Williams
    - You may get games in other chapters areas (specifically Empire, Boston, or Connecticut Chapters).
  - ECFOA (Milt Halstead) and NFOC (Bill Schuster)
    - New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Western New York schools
    - More travel is generally required.

## Meeting Requirements

- 10 meetings per year are held. Generally on Tuesday evenings.
  - General meetings (6) including required meetings below
    - Berkshire area in Massachusetts (Lee/Lenox)
  - Regional meetings (4)
    - Albany
    - Berkshire
    - Mid-Hudson Valley
    - Springfield
- Required meetings
  - Interpretation Meeting June. You can attend other chapters interpretation meetings if you have a conflict
  - D-III Clinics (Late July/Early August) you can attend other chapters clinics if you have a conflict.
  - Business Meeting (Late October)
- Attendance at (8) meetings are REQUIRED.

## Meeting Format

- The meeting schedule and format is set each year by the Executive and Interpretation committees, but generally includes the following:
  - Short quiz (5 to 10 questions) to get everyone thinking about the rules
  - Presentation by fellow members or guest speakers (former members, ACC officials, CAA/Ivy/Patriot officials) on mechanics.
  - Review of any game situations or issues.
  - Film reviews or study films are generally used in the regional meetings.

## Other Requirements

#### Chapter Dues

- \$50 per year are due in November for the next season
- Covers
  - EAIFO dues
  - Dinner meeting
  - Chapter dues

#### Physical

- An annual doctor's physical is required. The forms will be supplied and your doctor must sign.
- To be returned to the AFOA, NFOC, or ECFOA in July

#### General Rules

- Get things in on time!!!
  - Supervisors do not want to have to chase you down for your physical, dues, etc.
  - You may not get games if you do not get your paperwork in on time.
- Do not call supervisors office without seeing if your question can be answered locally through fellow officials, directors, or secretary.
- Keep your availability up to date.
  - -- Online system with AFOA (Arbiter)
  - Online system with NFOC and ECFOA (Zebraweb)
- If you get a game from the office, do not turn it down or turn it back.
  - Obviously in the case of emergencies there are exceptions.

#### Common Questions

- When will I get to the NFL?
  - Odds are NEVER!!!
- When will I get to do the (Rose, Orange, Citrus, ... pick your favorite fruit, flower, animal, or company) Bowl?
  - Odds are only slightly better than the previous question but not much!!!
