 - Sideline warning is back no flag first offence Bill wants us to work on sideline control
 - Throw a flag on a coach if he is out of control DON'T throw a second one!

- Scrimmage kick that is down inside 5 put on exact spot do not place on the tick
- Running plays that end in Team A area use iron cross mechanics
- R should move to the left side with a left-handed QB the mechanic was changes because of the center juge and we won't be using one.
- 3. Points of Emphasis
 - Targeting
 - Pace of play
 - UNS
 - Sideline management
 - Contacting a coach is a 15-yard penalty and does not count as one of the sideline warnings
- 4. Other Ward comments
 - Bill mentioned that there is a possibility this season that we will get a championship game assignment

Framingham Clinic - Saturday August 1 a Bill Ward key points:

- 1. Overall, coaches were happy with our performance in 2014 several comments from coaches:
- a. Coaches were happy the way we called Targeting and DQs.
- b. Coaches were not happy with many calls not made at the Point of Attack. As well, calls made away from the POA. Bill emphasized we need to do a better job getting key calls at the POA.
- c. Coaches send many film clips in through HUDL. If Bill sends a clip to you for a comment, he expects a response...short and concise.
- d. Coaches want "more" communication on sidelines talk about calls, communicate.
- 2. New rules -
- a. Handling Coaches will be a point of emphasis he expects us to use the Warning "step up" process, but will support an UNS call on a coach "out of control". We need to use restraint, but he will support UNS if called.
- b. The dead ball spots this year on all change of possessions, punts, and kicks needs to be placed at the exact spot it becomes dead not to the advance tick.
- c. KCI if there is contact, regardless if the R catches the punt or not he wants a flag if no contact, no flag.
- 3. DPI/OPI there were too many called last year all crews are expected to review advantage/disadvantage should be Cadillac calls.
