We have secured two conferences that the AFOA will be assigning football officials for this upcoming season - The MASCAC and the CCC (which has added another school to the conference for this season). Additionally, we are excited to report that both conferences have signed a new 3 year contract to use AFOA officials along with a modest increase in game fees. Staffing selections will be announced in early May. We have not finalized this summer's clinic date or the site at which it will be held - we should be making that decision soon. Couple of issues from last season. Travel - We realize that travel is a problem for some of you and that long trips can be challenging; however we expect all of our staff to be willing to go where assigned.- Husson is one of the schools that joined the CCC so all will need to travel to Maine at least once this season. Conditioning – It is important that you immediately start a program to get yourself in shape to officiate college football. Your appearance plays a big role in gaining the confidence of coaches and the possibility of advancement to Division 1.
