

1. Second down and 4 to go at the A-9. The team A QB is sacked in the end zone for an apparent safety. Team B is flagged for defensive offside. When will the game clock start, following the 5 yard penalty and new first down for Team A?
 - a. On the snap
 - b. On the ready for play

2. Team A is ahead 14 - 13 and Team B is out of team timeouts in the second quarter. The offense fails to reach the line to gain on 3rd down. 48 seconds remain on the clock and the game clock is running. Immediately after this 3rd down play ends, a Team B player is down on the ground injured. (Select all the correct answers below)
 - a. Team A may elect to run 10 seconds off the clock.
 - b. The game clock starts on the ready for play signal.
 - c. The play clock is set at 25 seconds.

3. Fourth down and 5 yards to go at the A-33. Team A is in scrimmage kick formation. They fake the punt and run to the left sideline. The ball carrier is hit and driven out of bounds at the A-49. About 10 minutes remain in the quarter.

6. Fourth down and 1 to go at the B-25. On the last play of the third quarter, QB A5 is called for intentional grounding at the B-30. Please indicate if the following statement is correct:
Following the penalty enforcement, the period will be extended with an untimed down.

- a. No, the quarter is over; Team B will start the next quarter (with a timed down)
 - b. No, the quarter is over; Team B will start the next quarter with an untimed down
 - c. Yes, the statement is correct
7. Second down and 8 to go at the B-45. It is the second quarter. Team A is ahead in score by 7 points and Team B is out of team timeouts. The play ends at the B-40 with 51 seconds on the clock and the game clock running. Immediately when the ball is dead, an injured Team B player is down on the ground. An official immediately stops the game clock. (Select all the correct answers below)
- a. The game clock starts on the ready for play when the 10 second subtraction is applied. When team A refuses the 10 second subtraction it starts on the snap.
 - b. The visible play clock starts with 25 seconds
 - c. A 10 second subtraction is possible. The gameclock will have 41 seconds remaining.
8. 1/10 at the B-40. On a forward pass play, the Left Tackle engages the defender above the waist at the line of scrimmage. The Team A Center blocks this same defender below the thigh. The completed pass play ends results in a touchdown.
- a. A, 1/25 at the A-45; snap
 - b. A, 1/25 at the A-45; ready for play
 - c. Not a foul; both Team A players are unrestricted linemen
9. On second down, with 1:12 remaining in the second quarter, Team A fumbles at the B-19. The loose ball rolls out of bounds at the B-15. Please mark if the following statements are correct.
- a. The game clock starts on the ready for play
 - b. The next snap is from the B-15 yardline
10. Team A completes a pass play into the end zone for a touchdown. Left Tackle A53 is called for holding. When will the game clock start following the penalty enforcement?
- a. On the snap
 - b. The next play is an untimed down
 - c. On the ready for play
11. With 0:32 remaining in the second quarter, Team A fumbles at the B-28. The loose ball rolls out of bounds at the B-25. When will the game clock start?
- a. On the snap
 - b. On the ready for play signal
12. Team A is in scrimmage kick formation at the B-48. The game clock is running. Team A intentionally let the play clock expire for a delay of game. Please mark if the following statements are correct.
- a. If the penalty is accepted, the game clock starts on the snap

- b. If the penalty is declined, the game clock starts on the ready for play
13. 4th & 7 from the A-30. The gameclock is running. Team A punts and the receiver signals for a fair catch at the B-32. The ball goes through his arms and rolls to the B-35 where Team A recovers the ball. The Back Judge sounds his whistle...Question A) just BEFORE the muff. Question B) just AFTER the muff but before team A recovers the ball. Select all correct answers.
- Answer for Question A: Team A ball, replay down.
 - Answer for Question B: Team B ball, 1-10 at the B-32.
 - The game clock starts on the snap on the next play
14. Second down and 4 at the A--32. The Quarterback passes to a Receiver at the A--45. He catches the ball and is hit and fumbles at the 50. The ball is recovered immediately by the defense at the B-48. After the pass, Team B was called for roughing the passer.
- Team A ball, 1 and 10 A-47; clock on the ready for play
 - Team A ball, 1 and 10 A-47; clock on the snap
 - Team A ball, 1 and 10 B-48; clock on the snap
 - Team A ball, 1 and 10 B-35; clock on the ready for play
15. Late in the half Team A completes the pass to the B-8 for a first down. The ball is spotted at the right hash with Team A hustling to the line to get a snap off. After the referee winds the clock and before the ball is snapped, a Team A player pushes/strikes his opponent who is heading back to the Team B side of the ball. When the clock is stopped for the dead-ball foul it reads 0:33. Team A is out of timeouts. Following the penalty it will be...?
- First and goal at the B--23; 0:33 remains on the clock
 - First and 10 at the B--23; 0:23 remains on the clock
 - First and goal at the B--23; 0:23 remains on the clock
 - First and 10 at the B--23; 0:33 remains on the clock
16. Midway through the third quarter, it is fourth and 13 at team B's 28 yardline. Team A's attempted field goal is successful. B33 is flagged for holding while the ball is in flight. Select all the correct answers.
- Team A may keep the points and have the penalty enforced on the succeeding kickoff.
 - If the penalty is enforced, the clock starts on the snap.
 - Team A receives an automatic first down
 - The penalty is declined by rule
 - Team A may have the penalty enforced from the previous spot
17. Second down and 2 at the B-33. Team B is ahead in score. Team A is out of timeouts in the fourth quarter. A17 runs to the B-24 where he throws the ball forward and incomplete to stop the clock. The game clock shows 0:07.
- 1-10 at the B-24, clock on the snap. 5 yard penalty enforced from the B-24.

- b. 1-10 at the B-29. Clock on the ready for play because illegal pass to stop the clock.
 - c. Game over because this play qualifies for the 10 second subtraction.
18. Free kick from the A-35. A23's kick is short. No Team B players are in the vicinity when A88 hits the kick with his hand backward on A's 49 yardline. The ball lands on A's 46 where it is recovered and grounded by A74. Please mark the correct answer(s).
- a. Team B will next snap the ball on the spot of illegal touching
 - b. The bat by A88 is legal
 - c. The game clock is not started during this play
19. 4th and 15 from midfield. Team A punts, but the kick is short. B33 tries to recover the ball at the B-41, without having firm possession or control of the ball. At the B-43, the ball bounces off the body of B33. A60 recovers the ball at the B-45 and advances it to the B-42. Please select all of the correct answers.
- a. Team B next snaps the ball
 - b. The next snap is from the B-42
 - c. The game clock starts on the snap
 - d. B33 has fumbled the ball at the B-43
20. It's the final minute of the fourth period. Team A is behind one score. On fourth down with 3 to go at the A-35, the quarterback runs with the ball. He comes across the Line of Scrimmage near the left hashmark. The defense rushes to the quarterback. Being 6 yards downfield at the A-41 and near the sideline, he throws an incomplete forward pass. The ball lands out of bounds. Please select all of the correct answers.
- a. Accept the penalty for intentional grounding. 1-10 team B at the A-36.
 - b. The loss of down provision conflicts with the new series awarded to team A. 1-10 team A at the A-36
 - c. Decline the penalty. 1-10 team B at the A-35
 - d. Accept the penalty for an illegal forward pass. 1-10 team B at the A-36.
